

WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

HINCH LOOKS TO CONTINUE HOT START:

James Hinchcliffe started the IZOD IndyCar Series season by scoring his first Indy car win in the season-opening Honda Grand Prix of St. Petersburg. The former Sunoco Rookie of the Year made his series debut at Barber in 2011 and led a lap at the track last season. Can he continue his strong start to the 2013 season by adding another first at Barber Motorsports Park?



DINGER'S DEBUT: After three successful tests with Team Penske, A.J. Allmendinger will return to his racing roots at the Honda Indy Grand Prix of Alabama. The Californian made his name in open-wheel racing before moving to NASCAR and hopes to recapture the success he had as a Champ Car regular at Barber as he tunes up for his Indianapolis 500 debut.

KEEP AN EYE ON SIMONA: A strong sixth-place finish at St. Petersburg showed that Simona de Silvestro is ready to have a breakout season. The Swiss driver looked poised to make a podium finish in her KV Racing Technology debut before fading to sixth. Can the Swiss Missile hit the target at Barber?
