WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:



HUNTER-REAY SEEKS REPEAT WIN ON STREETS OF TORONTO: Reigning IZOD IndyCar Series champion Ryan Hunter-Reay used a three-race win streak that included a victory at Toronto (*above*) to propel himself into championship contention in 2012. He returns to the track seeking his fourth straight trip to the Podium. Can Hunter-Reay, who repeated at Milwaukee, make history repeat itself again at Toronto?

"WILL TO WIN" AT TORONTO: Will Power hasn't won a race in 2013, but 2010 Honda Indy Toronto champion would like to add another win on the streets of Exhibition Place to his résumé. The Australian has a pair of wins at Toronto, winning in 2007 at the temporary circuit in Champ Car and again in 2010. Can Power, also the 2011 pole winner, become a three-time race winner?

WELCOME TO HINCHTOWN: James Hinchcliffe (right) attended the Honda Indy Toronto for the first time as an 18-month-old toddler. This year, the Toronto native will race in his hometown with a chance to win in front of the Canadian crowd. Can Hinch, who leads the IZOD IndyCar Series with three wins, visit Victory Lane in his hometown race?



SERIES ENTERS SECOND DOUBLEHEADER WEEKEND: Honda Indy Toronto will mark the second of three doubleheaders on the 2013 IZOD IndyCar Series schedule. The series will race a pair of 85-lap races Saturday and Sunday on the 1.75-mile temporary street circuit, posing a unique challenge for IZOD IndyCar Series drivers and teams. In addition, SONAX will offer a \$50,000 bonus to any driver who can win both races through the SONAX Perfect Finish Award. Can one driver sweep the races and be crowned "king of the streets" in Toronto?
