## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

**RACE FOR THE TITLE BEGINS:** Juan Pablo Montoya (right) has held the Verizon IndyCar Series point lead since the season began at St. Petersburg. He carries a healthy 46-point advantage over defending series champion Will Power heading into the ABC Supply Wisconsin 250 at Milwaukee IndyFest. Can Power repeat at Milwaukee (where Team Penske has eight wins) and cut into his teammate's points lead?



**HUNTER-REAY AIMS FOR FOURTH MILWAUKEE WIN:** Ryan Hunter-Reay returns to the Milwaukee Mile seeking his fourth win on the historic oval. Hunter-Reay led every lap of the 2004 Champ Car race and won back-to-back races in 2012 and 2013. Can he recapture his Milwaukee magic and score his first win of 2015?

**TK HOPES TO CONTINUE MILWAUKEE MASTERY:** With seven top-five finishes in his last 10 starts at Milwaukee, Tony Kanaan has definitely earned the title of "Milwaukee Master." Kanaan won at Milwaukee in 2006 and 2007, finished second in 2012 and third in 2014. The ABC Supply Wisconsin 250 will mark Kanaan's 245th consecutive Indy car start, which will extend his all-time record. Can Kanaan add a third Milwaukee trophy this weekend?
