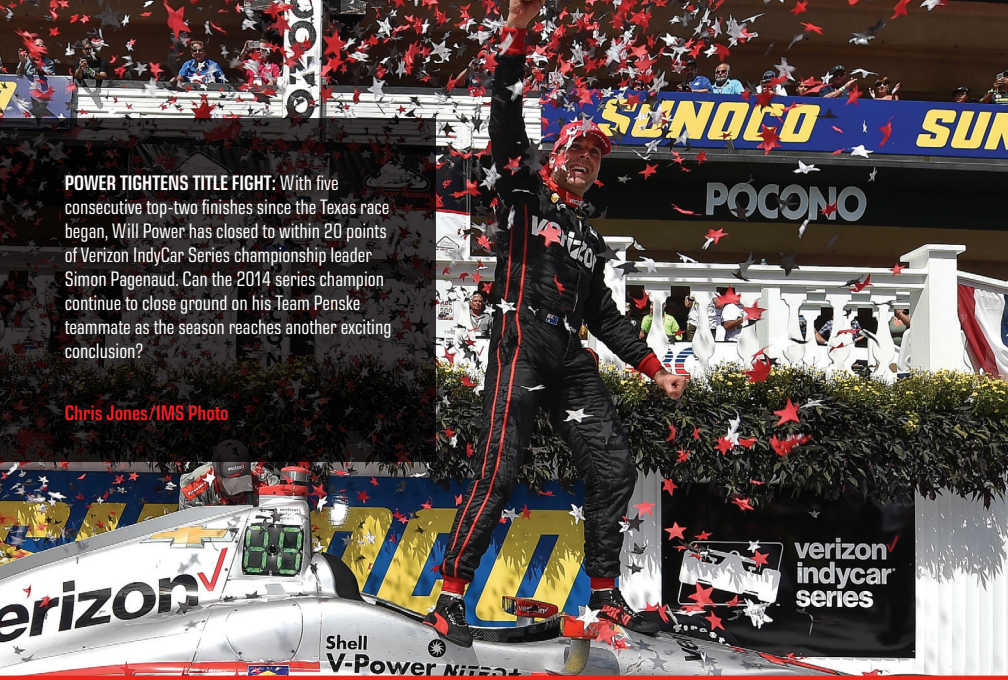

The race will resume on Lap 72 and the green will fly on the second time past the flag stand.
