

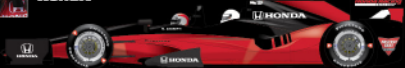

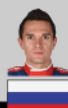

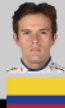

Will he continue to be the series' top dog there?

## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

- FOUR WINNERS IN FOUR RACES:** There have been four different winners in the four races thus far in 2017: Sebastien Bourdais (Streets of St. Petersburg), James Hinchcliffe (Streets of Long Beach), Josef Newgarden (Barber Motorsports Park) and Simon Pagenaud (Phoenix Raceway). Will this weekend see the fifth winner of the season?
- PENSKER ON POLE IN 2017:** Drivers from Team Penske are the only drivers to earn the Verizon P1 Award in 2017. Will Power (St. Petersburg and Barber) and Helio Castroneves (Phoenix and Long Beach) earned Verizon P1 Awards through qualifying. Can Penske continue its dominance in qualifying?
- SIX STRIVE FOR IMS DOUBLE:** Six drivers have a chance to become the first driver to win INDYCAR races on both the Indianapolis Motor Speedway's road course and the famed 2.5-mile oval: Helio Castroneves, Scott Dixon, Ryan Hunter-Reay, Tony Kanaan, Juan Pablo Montoya and Alexander Rossi have all won the Indianapolis 500 but none have won on the road course at IMS.

## LED DISPLAY PANELS:



### POSITION: RED

Primary display, showing the car's position in the running order. Blinks when the position has changed from previous lap.

Example: Car is running in P12.



### PUSH-TO-PASS: FLASHES GREEN

Display flashes "PP" in green while the car's push-to-pass is active.

Example: Car with active P2P.



### PIT STOP TIMER: GREEN

Display shows a running clock during a pit stop in seconds.

Example: 7.9-second pit
