
The scholarship program for each series' champion is unequaled anywhere in the world. For 2018, the Indy Lights champion will once again earn a guaranteed minimum of a three-race program for the following year's Verizon IndyCar Series, including the Indianapolis 500. The Pro Mazda champion will receive a scholarship of \$790,300 to advance to Indy Lights and the USF2000 champion will receive a scholarship of \$325,000 to graduate to Pro Mazda.
