
# *2022 QUALIFYING FORMAT 101*

The fastest two days on the NTT INDYCAR SERIES schedule are here - PPG Armed Forces Qualifying weekend. Over two days, drivers and teams will fight for one of the 33 positions in the starting field for the 106th Running of the Indianapolis 500 presented by Gainbridge.

## SATURDAY, MAY 21 11 AM ET - 6 PM ET peacock



NTT INDYCAR SERIES drivers and teams will attempt to qualify during Day One, Saturday, May 21. Top 12 qualifying (final order of positions 7-12) and Firestone Fast Six (final order of position 1-6) will be determined during Day Two, Sunday May 22. Once every car in the qualifying order for Saturday has been presented at least one chance to qualify, teams must choose from two lanes for second and subsequent attempts. Cars in the priority lane (Lane 1) must withdraw their qualified time - if the car has one - but get priority access to the track ahead of Lane 2. Lane 2 is for cars that have already qualified but wish to improve their position.

### TOP 12 OUALIFYING


#### **POSITIONS 7-12 DETERMINED**

Order based on Saturday times, slowest to fastest. Each entry is guaranteed one attempt. The fastest six advance to the Firestone Fast Six to determine positions 1-6.

#### Firestone Fast Six Fan Laps

The break between Sunday's Top 12 and Firestone Fast Six will include two laps behind the Corvette Z06 70th Anniversary Edition Pace Car. Traveling at 100 mph, the fan salute for the remaining six entries will also allow air to flow through the air ducts to help cool the engines before the dramatic qualifying laps for pole position.

Before and after the pace laps, two five-minute work windows will be allowed, where teams can add or remove side pod shutters, add fuel, adjust front and rear wings and change tire air pressure. Changing tires after the Top 12 will only be allowed in the work window immediately prior to the Firestone Fast Six.



## FIRESTONE FAST SIX

#### **POSITIONS 1-6 DETERMINED**

Order based on times from Top 12 qualifying, slowest to fastest. Each entry is guaranteed one attempt. The fastest driver in the Firestone Fast Six will earn the coveted NTT P1 Award for pole.
